### **Various Updates from Sharon Rogers and Lori Brucker, Co-Presidents:**

- **Raffle Tickets** – winners will be drawn on Friday at the first home Varsity game. No ticket stubs will be accepted that evening. Only 4 players have not participated in this mandatory fundraiser and they will be notified by mail that their son will not be eligible for gifts at the year-end banquet nor will the parents be able to attend.
- **Bar Bingo** – was very successful. Approximately \$7,200 after expenses was raised for the players. In spite of the success, we did not have very much volunteer help or football family presence. Would like to do again next year with hopes of more football participation. Jan Roach, past booster president, has had a recurrence of her illness and all of the proceeds from the sale of Jell-O shots at Bar Bingo were donated to Jan on behalf of the football boosters.
- **Meet the Players** – all had a great time and the food from Cyd West was awesome. All players received gifts per their class year. Freshman ties were taken by Coach Scarillo to distribute for freshman that did not attend. Patti Esposito, sophomore rep, has the wind suits for sophomores that were not in attendance.
- **Programs** – the programs have gone to print and they will be ready for Friday's game. Due to rising costs, we have purchased a smaller quantity this year and we will not be giving a copy to each of the players at the banquet as we have in the past. The seniors will receive one at the banquet. Please purchase your programs early before they run out!
- **Friday Night Game/Youth Night** – this Friday is Youth Night for BPJF and the cheerleaders. As in the past, they will line up beginning at 6:30 p.m. and will enter the stadium and be introduced to the community. This also means that the stadium will be much fuller and we will need the assistance of those volunteers for 50/50, concessions and program and t-shirt sales.
- **Concessions** – being coordinated by Deb Hultz, Tom Conaboy and Dan Hardinger. They are not solely manning the concession stand. **Every** freshman family is obligated to take their turn at helping out in the concession stand.
